**Subject:** NWOEA Unit I Rep on OEA Board of Directors Vacancy

The election of Dan Greenberg as the NEA Director #5 has created a vacancy on the NWOEA and OEA Board of Directors. If you or any other Unit I NWOEA member is interested in serving as the NWOEA Unit I Representative on the OEA Board of Directors, please declare this interest in writing or by email. You may also fax your letter of interest to the NWOEA Center. The fax number is 1-419-422-3417. The statement of interest must be communicated to the NWOEA Center by September 14, 2018. The NWOEA Board of Directors will consider the appointment of a Unit I member to fill the position of NWOEA Representative on the OEA Board of Directors at the September 18, 2018 meeting.

The appointee will serve on the OEA Board of Directors during the 2018-2019 school year with term effective upon appointment. If an appointee desires to continue as a Unit I NWOEA Board of Directors member beyond the date of his/her appointment, he/she will need to run for election at the NWOEA RA in 2019 to complete the remainder of the vacated term which ends July 14, 2020.

The OEA Board of Directors meets approximately five times throughout the year on Saturdays at the OEA Headquarters in Columbus, prior to both RA's, and for a retreat in the Summer. Board of Directors members are also expected to attend assigned OEA committee meetings; OEA events (e.g. Summer Leadership Academy, OEA Awards Reception, DLAMC Dinner, legislative receptions, etc.); NEA, OEA, and NWOEA RA's; and NWOEA Board of Directors meetings. As a member of the NWOEA Board of Directors, the NWOEA Unit Representatives on the OEA Board of Directors are assigned to NWOEA Committees, and are also encouraged to attend NWOEA workshops, RA's, and other District sponsored events. When attending OEA and NWOEA activities and meetings, board members are reimbursed by OEA for mileage at the IRS rate, provided meals, and furnished lodging when necessary.
